The Nigerian equity market closed positive as the All-Share Index gained 1.21% to settle the year-to-date return of the market at (3.26%).

The Index closed at 41,584.94 basis point against the previous close of 41,088.96 basis point while Market Capitalization closed at 21,753,547,496,119.70 against previous close of 21,494,094,629,849.00. Volume traded increased by 40.47% from 333,096,795 to 467,886,480 while the total value of stocks traded increased by 110.79% from 2,640,428,587.92 to 5,565,767,469.95 in 5,990 deals compared to 5,640 deals traded previously.
