Dear Esteemed Investor,

The Nigerian equity market closed positive as the All-Share Index gained 0.57% to settle the year-to-date return of the market at (4.71%).

The Index closed at 42,169.41 basis point against the previous close of 41,930.73 basis point while Market Capitalization closed at 22,059,291,519,201.50 against previous close of 21,934,431,128,595.20. Volume traded increased by 2.16% from 543,597,202 to 555,321,328 while the total value of stocks traded decreased by 21.28% from 7,321,959,683.47 to 5,764,078,832.09 in 6,386 deals compared to 6,770 deals traded previously.
